Nut Free School	Bikes and Scooters		
We are an allergy aware and nut free school. Some of our children have allergies and should they be exposed to nuts in any form they could have an extremely severe reaction. Please take extra care to ensure nuts and food containing nuts do not come into school. Thank you.	It is always pleasing to see so many children travelling to and from school on their bikes and scooters. In the interests of safety please ensure the following: - All children on their bike or scooter MUST wear a helmet. - Bikes and scooters need to be dismounted and pushed up to the parking area, school is very busy and it is unsafe to ride on the path up to and down from school. - Bikes and scooters are not permitted on the playground.	This will not follow a parents evening format and formal appointments are not required. We ask on this date that you collect your child first and then re-enter school with them via their classroom doors once all of the children have been safely dismissed. <i>We politely ask that you wait until 3.40 before re-entering school through your child's correct entrance to enable us to safely dismiss all children first.</i>
